CHARACTERS

ADAM COLBY (30s)

a lonely, divorced, and down-to-earth man who doubts the existence of marital love

PEARL "HUCK" ALEXANDER (10 – 90s)

a spirited lady of intelligence, grace, and wit who desires to find her soulmate and never let go

GABE ALEXANDER (30s - 80s)

an amiable bookkeeper with a mischievous grin who believes that a successful marriage is basic math

CLARK RICHARDS (30s)

a handsome and keen man of self-importance who has adored Huck since they were children

YEVETTE GALLOWAY (30s)

a blunt woman with a soft heart who knows the Alexander's secret to long-lasting love

MISTER JACK (60s)

a pleasant, trustworthy man with a mysterious air who takes an active interest in shaping hope

STORY

Recently divorced, Adam Colby discovers a collection of antique postcards at Gabe and Huck Alexander's estate sale. For sixty years, Gabe composed an original love poem on the back of a postcard, signed it "Forever, Gabe", and mailed it to his wife on Friday.

Young Huck meets her guardian angel Mister Jack who inspires her to look for her soulmate.

Ten years later, Gabe meets soon-to-be-married Huck and decides she is the girl he'll marry. He vows to protect their love from The Long Division. Huck and Gabe spend the day together in Galveston, becoming engaged on a moonlit beach. Mister Jack prevents Huck's former fiance, Clark Richards, from killing Gabe.

Hoping to uncover the Alexander's secret to long-lasting marriage, Adam meets with Yevette Galloway, their housekeeper's daughter.

Newly married, Huck and Gabe face familial disapproval, a sailboating accident, and a disastrous disagreement. Clark is murdered by the Chicago mob but Huck is rescued by famous Texas Ranger Manuel T. Gonzaullas (aka The Lone Wolf). Gabe and Huck separate until he meets Mister Jack who reveals the depth of his selfish pride. Gabe begs God's forgiveness and drives through the night to reconcile with Huck. Clark's early death sparks a new fear in Huck: losing Gabe. Yevette hands Gabe's final postcard to Adam and tells him about when Gabe begins to die.

Gabe and Huck share more adventures together until the dreadful Texas City Disaster. Huck finds Gabe under the protection of Mister Jack, but as the years pass Gabe develops emphysema and he dies in intensive care. Huck drives to the sunlit dell where she first met Mister Jack and rails at him. A sudden breeze reveals two orchid buds joined into a single magnificent bloom. Huck realizes Gabe is still alive because his love remains in her heart.

Decades later, Gabe visits Huck in a dream at the extended care facility where she now resides, and he promises to come back for her soon. When Huck awakens, she learns Yevette discovered a final, undelivered postcard. Yevette reads it aloud, and Huck dies peacefully.

Adam meets Yevette once more, and she reveals the secret to a lasting marriage: the power of love through hope. Adam grabs hope, a second chance, and a new beginning.
